- To spot the AI-written content, tool like AI-detector needs to be implemented.

- GPTZero is an **AI detection tool developed to flag AI-generated text**
- Built specifically with educators and institutions in mind
- Free to use at www.GPTZero.me

More than an AI detector.

GPTZero researchers uncover the shortcomings of ChatGPT and major AI models to ensure every word is worth reading.

Key Features for Instructors

- Accepts copy-pasted text or uploaded files (.docx, .pdf)
- Sentence-by-sentence color coding for easy review
- **Free** for 10,000 free credits.
- **Free** grammar check and writing feedback.

Important Considerations

- **Not 100% foolproof:** GPTZero gives probabilities, not definitive proof
- Risk of **false positives**, especially with well-edited human work
- Should be used in conjunction with:
 - Rubric-based grading
 - Student interviews/oral assessments
 - Draft progression tracking
